Home for Good has helped 75 people achieve housing stability as of December 2023—and

Receiving funding based on successes

Jon shuffled between Brother Francis, Sullivan Arena and Centennial Park before moving into Guest House. He'd lost his home when his mother died.

"Once you're on the streets, it's hard to get off," says Jon. "For a long time, I didn't give a hoot." Then, Home for Good identified Jon as a person to help.

"A case manager came to my tent and told me she was working on getting me into a home," he says. When she came back, he recalls her saying, "Pack up your stuff. You're moving into your own home."

Jon's remained housed and received support for a year. "I want to be independent and feel like I'm contributing." Having a place to call home is helping Jon take his next steps.

People who've experienced homelessness for a long time need extra help getting back on their feet. Home for Good connects them with housing and support services so, like Jon, they can all take their next steps.
