

DONOR OPTION POLICY

Frontier Community Services

100% of contributions to United Way of Anchorage (UWA), the UWA Community Fund, and UWA Community Impact Areas support local causes. No fees are charged for contributions made through any United Way to another. UWA charges a 13% processing fee for pledges designated to qualified nonprofit agencies that provide health and human care services in Alaska. Agencies must be designated by the Internal Revenue Service as a 501(c)3 tax exempt organization. Churches, religious programs, educational institutions and foundations, cultural groups, service clubs, legal defense funds and political organizations are not eligible. United Way of Anchorage does not charge a fee to become a member agency or to retain membership status.
