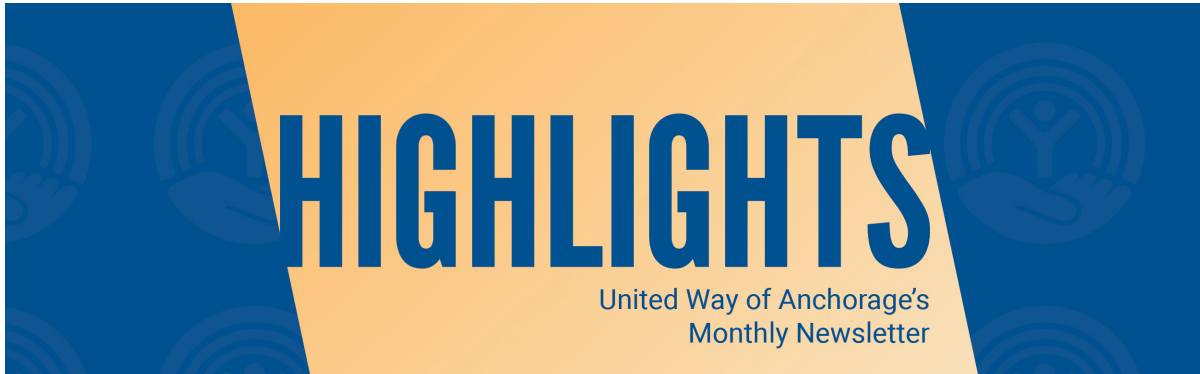

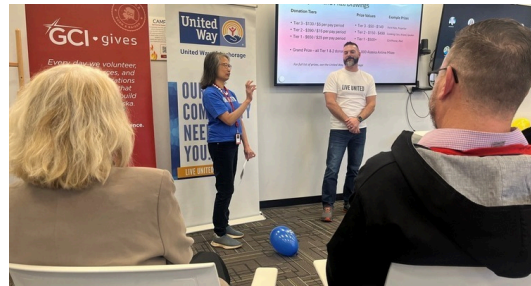
Caregiver program
